876 Iowa Administrative Code 4.19(3)(d) requires a party in a contested case before the Iowa Division of Workers' Compensation ("Division") to file proposed exhibits in the Workers' Compensation Electronic System ("WCES") at least 14 days before hearing, unless the party is excused from using WCES and then the excused party must file the proposed exhibits with the Division at least 14 days before hearing. The rule does not require a party to serve the proposed exhibits on the other parties in the contested case at the time the proposed exhibits are filed.

It is therefore ordered that when a party files proposed exhibits in WCES, or with the Division if the party is excused from using WCES, the party shall contemporaneously serve all other parties in the contested case with a copy of the proposed exhibits through regular mail or personal delivery as set forth in 876 Iowa Administrative Code 4.13.
