

IOWA MATCH DATA TABLE

March 17, 2000

The Match Data Table is designed to convey which data elements should be used as primary or secondary “match” data elements. It is used to identify a transaction as a new claim to create, or match to an existing claim for updating and processing. This process is primarily employed on a Correction (MTC-CO) and Change (MTC- 02). Match data must be agreed upon between each trading partner and specified here. A trading partner should identify primary match data element(s) and two or more secondary match data elements.

The data element names are listed down in the center column. Place an ‘X’ in the appropriate column indicated as P (primary) or S (secondary) match data.
